NOTICE INVITING BIDS FOR

VARIOUS RETENTION BASIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

The City of San Jacinto (“City”) is accepting informal bids for Various Retention Basin Improvements, here-by listed as “Project”. Bid proposals must be submitted at the office of the City Clerk, or the Public Works Offices, no later than **March 15, 2010, at 5:00 p.m.**, at which time or thereafter said bids will be opened and reviewed. Bids received after this time will be invalid. Bids accepted shall be valid for 60 calendar days after the bid opening date.

The Project must be completed within 90 calendar days, beginning within thirty (30) calendar days after the date on which “City” authorization is confirmed. Project completion timeline may be extended only with authorization by City.

Informal electronic bids will be allowed to include email and fax machine.

All Project proposals and bids shall incorporate and comply with prevailing wage standards.

JOB WALK

PREVAILING WAGES

The Director of the State Department of Industrial Relations has determined THE GENERAL PREVAILING RATE OF PER DIEM WAGES IN THE LOCALITY in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the Contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are on online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr> The successful bidder and all subcontractor(s) under bidder shall comply with all applicable Labor Code provisions, which include, but are not limited to the payment of not less than the required prevailing rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, the employment of apprentices, the hours of labor and the debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following appropriate classification of contractor’s license, for the work bid upon, and must maintain the license(s) throughout the duration of the Contract.

Award of Contract: The City shall award the Contract for the Project to the lowest responsible bidder as determined from the base bid alone and any addendums that may be added to the bid documents. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding process.

Scope of Work (Performed at Each Site)

- 1) Clear and weed abate, disposing of all foliage, grade bottom base if necessary, incorporating weed blocker material and rock to match all designed and existing drainage grades, replace or stabilize existing soil if necessary;
- 2) Install 30 year or higher premium landscape weed blocker material to cover entire bottom base with or equivalent to: "Easy Gardener, Commercial Weed Block – 30 year". Weed blocker material sheeting will be overlapped a minimum of 4" inches when joining or matching;
- 3) Install and secure 4" inch pronged staples on all perimeter to include overlaps every 4' feet, and 4' feet on center on remaining material;
- 4) Place and compact 1 ½" inch to 2 ½" inch granite rock to a minimum depth of 6" inches over entire bottom base, covering weed blocker material;

Retention Basin Sites:

- 1) Sagecrest Development, Tract 29341, Zone 1 – approx 9,100 sq. ft.
- 2) Tesoro Development, Tract 30813, Zone 7 – approx 12,624 sq. ft.
- 3) Durango Development, Tract 31036, Zone 20 – approx 7,740 sq. ft.
- 4) The Ranch Development, Tract 30828, Zone 26 – approx 16,400 sq. ft. (two basins combined)
- 5) Tamarisk Development, Tract 32155, Zone 45 – approx 19,175 sq. ft.

NOTE: Each retention basin/development will be listed as a separate proposal amount (Example: 1) Sagecrest - \$4000, 2) Tesoro - \$5000, 3) Durango - \$3500 etc.)

- Retention basin square footage is approximate.

Contractor or Sub-contractor performing work will possess:

- ❖ City Of San Jacinto business license;
- ❖ State of California License registered with State Contractors Board;
- ❖ Worker Compensation Insurance;
- ❖ Liability insurance as required by City Of San Jacinto.

A copy of each listed document must be submitted to City within one (1) week after bid award. Failure to submit documentation will result in rejection of any contract.

Contractor is responsible and liable for: proper storage and disposal of all waste materials; maintaining proper BMP's per storm water regulations; maintaining proper traffic control measures; following any and all relevant State of California laws, codes and regulations; adhere to all City of San Jacinto municipal codes, ordinances and regulations.
