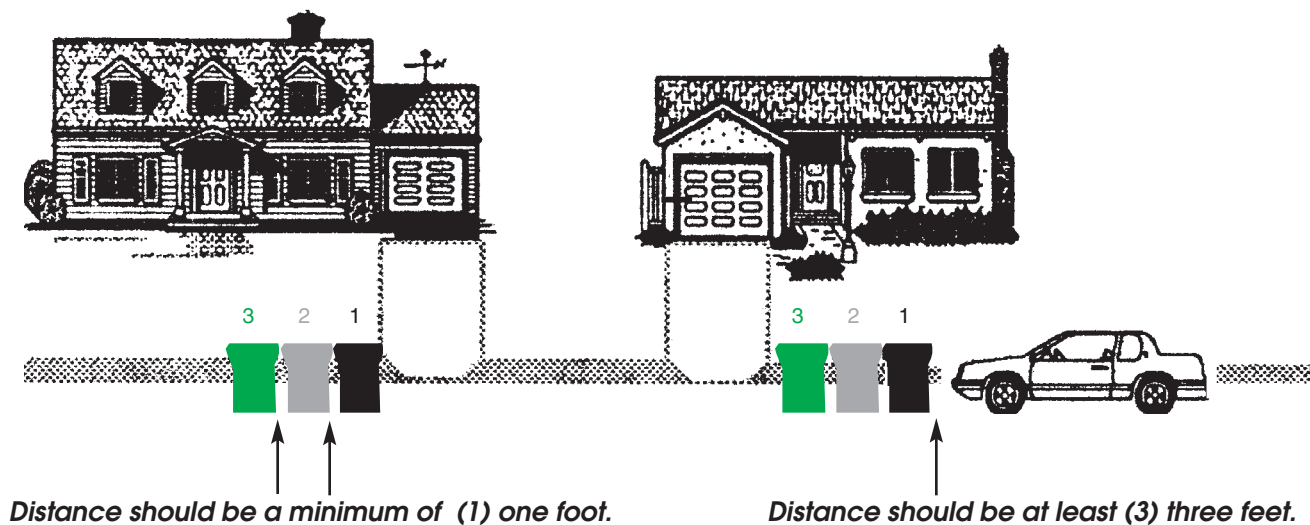
Please start using your new automated containers immediately. Because of the truck's robotic arm, the equipment is only able to service these specially designed containers that have been provided for you.

BLACK CONTAINER: #1 The black container is for all trash that does not apply to the recycling or greenwaste containers. This material will be transported directly to a county landfill. **Do not** place toxic or hazardous waste in any container.

GRAY CONTAINER: #2 The gray container is for recyclable materials. CR&R allows residents to place all recyclable items in one container. Separation and preparation of materials will be handled at the contractor's facility. Please refer to the other side of this brochure for the guidelines on materials collected.

GREEN CONTAINER: #3 The green container is for greenwaste materials. All greenwaste should be free of contaminants, such as plastic bags, paper bags, and other trash. Separation and preparation of the material will be handled at a composting facility. Please refer to the other side of this brochure for the guidelines on materials collected.

Please review the diagram below for proper placement of these new containers on collection day.



Place your containers near the corner of your driveway **on the curb** or at the edge of the street for those streets that have no curbs, with the arrows pointing toward the street. The container(s) need to be placed at least **three feet** away from any obstruction such as a fence, lamp post, or vehicle. Please do not place your containers in front of the mailbox. There must be at least **one foot** between each automated container. Do not place containers behind cars or one behind the other.

CR&R provides one of the most innovative collection and recycling programs in the state. This program combines the most cost effective method of trash collection with a state-of-the-art recycling and greenwaste program.

Automated collection is an efficient and safe process for collecting residential waste and recyclables. Through the use of a mechanical arm operated by the driver, trash is collected quickly and neatly. Each home is furnished with special containers which residents roll out to the curb on collection day.

When reading about our automated recycling program, you may ask yourself, how can I be involved . . . what can I do to help? This brochure is designed to answer your questions. The program was designed to maximize recycling and minimize costs, and it accomplishes both goals. The program recovers and recycles more materials than any other type of recycling program currently available. It also requires less work by the residents.

☆ HOW THE AUTOMATED PROGRAM WORKS

Each single family attached and detached unit will be provided with three containers for the collection of recyclables, greenwaste and trash.

☆ THE GRAY CONTAINER IS FOR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

CR&R allows residents to place all recyclable items in the gray container. The commingled materials will be transported to our facility where they will be processed, baled, and shipped to market.

☆ THE GREEN CONTAINER IS FOR GREENWASTE

CR&R allows residents to place all greenwaste items in the green container. The commingled materials will be transported to a composting facility where they will be processed and blended into finished compost material.

Please note all greenwaste materials should be sized to fit within the container

☆ THE BLACK CONTAINER IS FOR TRASH

All other items that do not apply to recyclables or greenwaste should be placed in the black container. Do not place liquids or hazardous waste in any container!

TIPS FOR THE RESIDENT

- ✓ Be sure to use only the containers provided, materials in other containers or on the side will not be collected.
- ✓ Place containers on the curb by 6:00 a.m. Remove empty containers within 24 hours of your service day. **No Exceptions!**
- ✓ Refrain from parking in the street on collection day.
- ✓ Place your recyclables and greenwaste in the appropriate containers.
- ✓ When moving, please call our office to stop billing and arrange pick up of the containers.
- ✓ **Holiday Schedule:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. If any of these holidays fall on a weekday, your service will be one day later following the holiday. (Example: Labor Day, Monday, everyone's service is one day later) (Example: Thanksgiving, Thursday, only Thursday and Friday customers will be one day later)
- ✓ If extra containers are needed, contact CR&R for prices.
- ✓ **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD TOXIC OR HAZARDOUS WASTE BE PLACED IN ANY OF THESE THREE CONTAINERS!**
